Job Title: Nurse Practitioner (NP)

Department: Clinical Care

Position Summary: The Nurse Practitioner (NP) works as a member of the medical team to provide health care to individuals by evaluating health problems and instituting therapy in collaboration with the supervising physician. Within the Physician-NP relationship, Nurse Practitioners exercise autonomy in medical decision-making and provide a broad range of diagnostic, and therapeutic services.

Education/ Qualifications:

- Graduate of an approved Nurse Practitioner Program
- Certified by the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners or the American Nurses Credentialing Center or both
- Licensed by the Minnesota State Board of Nursing
- DEA License
- Three to five years of experience preferred
- Proof of current COVID-19 Vaccination or medical or religious exemption on file with Human Resources

Performance Requirements:

- Ability to maintain quality control standards
- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations
- Ability to interpret clearly and establish/maintain effective working relationships with patients, medical staff, and the public
- Work well independently in addition to being skilled in interdisciplinary collaboration
- Demonstrates effective written and oral communication

Essential Functions:

- Maintains and reviews patients' medical record, records history and physical examinations and progress notes required to evaluate medical problems.
- Synthesizes data to determine preliminary diagnosis and develops and implements treatment plan utilizing principles of prevention.



- Collaborates with physicians in managing acute and long-term medical needs of patients while providing monitoring and continuity of care between provider visits.
- Participates in family conferences with physician partner.
- Writes and orders diagnostic studies and other special tests. Reviews tests and examination results and notifies appropriate persons.
- Interprets and integrates data and laboratory findings to determine appropriate diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and initiating or modifying treatment as necessary.
- Prescribes medications in compliance with the state law and Genevive guidelines.
- Instructs patient and family regarding medications and treatments. Provides patient and family education regarding health and illness.
- Triages telephone calls and provides consultation.
- Manages Medical Emergencies
- Provides the required billing information for services provided by the NP and maintains the documentation necessary for those services billed.
- Participates in professional development activities and maintains professional affiliations.
 Completes required number of continuing medical education (CME) hours and attends required meetings or committees as requested.
- Maintains patient confidentiality.
- Performs other duties as determined collaboratively by the supervising physician, NP, and administrators that are within the scope of practice of the NP.
- Maintains a copy of all professional records including current licensure, certification, continuing education, and other appropriate records to practice.
- Works with the Clinical Education Specialist and Precepts students

Physical/Mental Demands and Work Environment:

- Involves exposure to communicable diseases, medical prescriptions, toxic substances, and other conditions.
- Requires full range of body motion to get in and out of car, as travel is required.
- Frequent standing, walking, and sitting required for extended periods of time.
- Requires visual and hearing acuity.
- Able to lift a minimum of 25 pounds.
