Essential Functions:

- Review and collect patient data from Care Coordination staff
- Assist with audits
- Track PCA dates and ensure reporting is accurate
- Death reporting
- Compile all Part C data and send to Health Plans
- Enter data into Genevive reporting system with accuracy
- Work with the transition team to make member and physician calls
- Assist with entry into state reporting systems (MMIS or equivalent)
- Follow HIPAA guidelines when accessing and sharing patient information

Physical/Mental Demands and Work Environment:



- Work is performed in a normal home office environment
- Requires sitting and standing
- Perform highly complex and varied tasks requiring independent knowledge and its application to a variety of situations, as well as exercise of independent judgment
- Requires the use of office equipment, such as copiers, computers, telephones and fax machines
- May view computer screens for long periods of time.
- Vision must be correctable to 20/20 and hearing must be in a normal range for telephone contacts.
- Contract with nursing home staff, physicians, patients and families at nursing home may be frequent and interruptive.
- Must be able to prioritize activities when faced with competing demands.
