



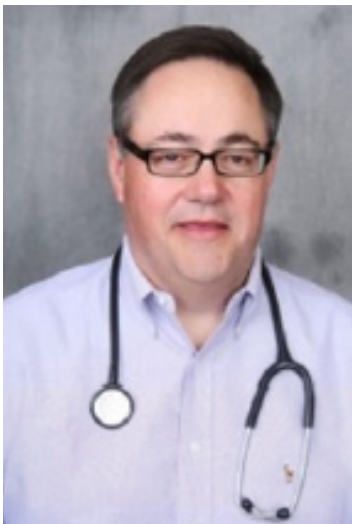
## Michelle Killam, APRN, CNP
