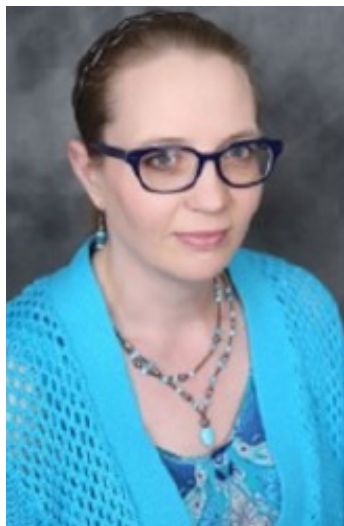




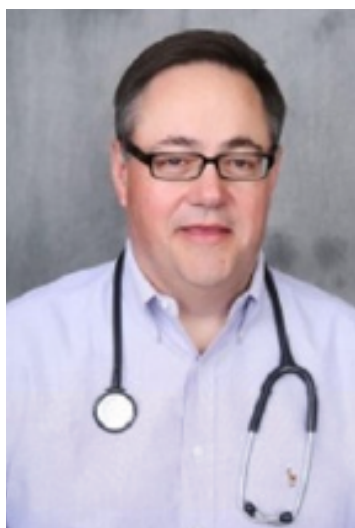
Melissa Sorenson, APRN, CNP
